An accelerated master's degree can help first time undergraduate students get a jump start on their master's degree. With this program, undergraduate students enrolled at The University of Alabama may count up to 12 credit hours toward both their undergraduate and master's degrees.

The Master of Science in Human Nutrition is a **30 credit-hour program** designed to prepare nutrition professionals to practice dietetics at an advanced level and/or pursue doctoral study. The program develops research skills, stimulates independent thought, and provides up-to-date knowledge in food and nutrition.

Minimum Application Requirements

- UA grade point average (GPA) of 3.7 or higher
 - *This GPA is effective for students admitted to AMP 8/15/2023 and later.*
- 90+ credit hours must be completed or in progress
- Prerequisites listed on page 2 must be completed or in progress.

Students may choose from the following concentrations/track. Note, courses listed in **red** may substitute for an undergraduate DPD course and may count toward both the Food and Nutrition BHS and Human Nutrition MS. More detailed curriculum information will be provided upon request.
